

Sample Pet Resume

A pet resume is the first introduction that your landlord will have to your pet. You want to highlight your pet's best attributes in the resume, and show that you are a responsible pet owner. Here's an example that shows some of the common things that can be included in your pet's resume.

Description

Max is a friendly and calm Border Collie/Black Lab cross that we have owned for four years. He has lived in apartments since he was a puppy and is an important member of our family. If you would like to meet Max, then we can bring him for a visit.

Give some basic information about your pet. Include age, breed, activity level, and how long you have owned your pet. You can also include other information that may help the landlord see that your pet will be a good addition to the building. You should also offer to bring your pet to visit.

Give some examples of some of the activities that your pet enjoys, and any training that you have done with your pet. This will show that you are a responsible pet owner, and that your pet is well behaved. If you have a cat, then you can let your landlord know that your cat is litter box trained and uses a scratching post.

Activities and Training

Max is housebroken and only barks when someone knocks on our door. He attended dog obedience classes when he was a puppy and he is involved in agility training. We walk or jog with Max twice a day and also visit the off leash park at least three times a week. Because he is so active, Max is happy to relax at home quietly while we are at work during the day.

Health

Max is neutered and all of his vaccinations are current. He goes to the veterinarian on a regular basis, and is a healthy dog. We can provide contact information for our veterinarian upon request.

State the general health of your pet. Mention whether or not your pet is spayed or neutered as well as any other health considerations that may be important. If you groom your dog, then put that in. If you brush your cat once a day, then state that too.

This is the part where you can put in any other information that you think your landlord may want to know about you.

About Us

We are a mature and responsible couple. We always clean up after Max, and we always wipe his paws off at entrances. We do not travel a lot, but when we are going to be away overnight or longer, Max goes to stay at a kennel. We are sure that Max will be a great addition to your building!
